

PROJECT UPDATE – ORION TAVERN

Gen-Eco Environmental Wood Products were selected to supply Ultralite Balsa Beams for the recently completed Orion Tavern at Springfield Lakes.

Architect – Brand & Slater Builder – Fardouly's Constructions



The core material was Balsa End-Grain panels, skinned with MDF and digitally printed with Rawinkk large format printing.



The beams ranged in depth from 150, 200 and 300mm and widths of 35, 50 and 75mm
The woodgrain selected for printing was Queensland Walnut.



Russell Field from Fardouly's Construction was very pleased with the beam installation and estimated they saved approximately \$20,000 over conventional timber beams. As the Balsa End-Grain beams are extremely lightweight, the cost saving was achieved by not having to structurally engineer the ceiling to take the weight of heavy timber beams.
